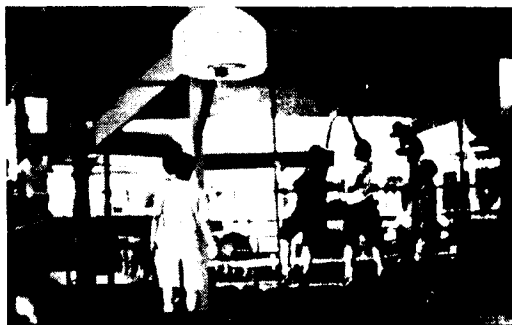

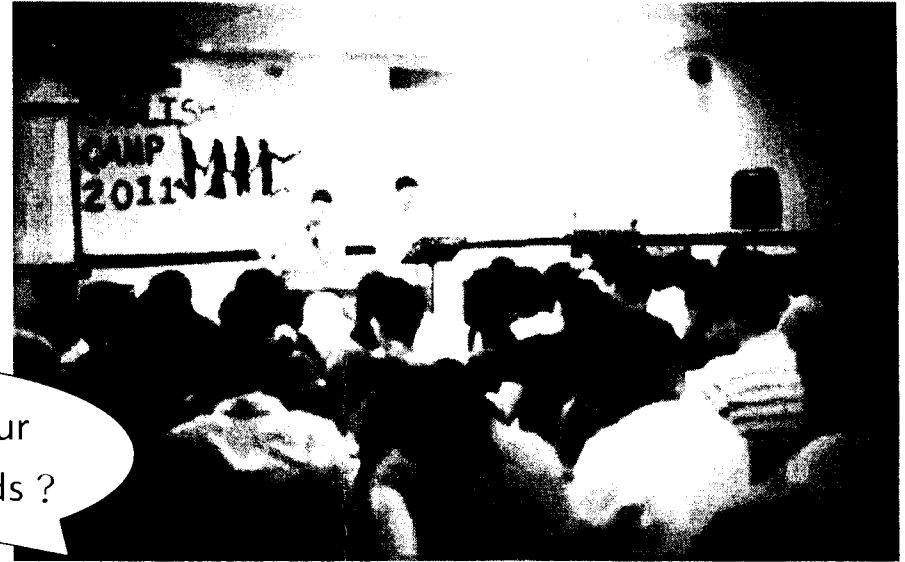
# PANAMA Short-Term Mission Q & A

## 1. Why short-term mission ?

Our response to the Great Commission;  
(Matt. 28:19-20, Acts 1:8, 2 Cor. 9:16-17)  
To spread the love of Christ Jesus;  
To deepen our ambition for evangelizing;  
To carry out the church's mission;  
To respond to Christ's love for us;  
To deepen relations with brothers & sisters;  
To deepen relations with God;  
To revive the church.

## 2. Why Panama ?

- There is a need. Out of the 130,000 Asians in Panama, only 700 are Christians.
- Panama has cried out. Ever since 1996, Pastor Leung has sought help from the North American Chinese churches.
- The Chinese Panamanians speak Cantonese, and the young adults love to learn English. Through the two languages, we can help them.



## 3. What about our neighbor's needs ?

- We have not neglected our neighbor's needs. If we look at the church's entire ministry plan, many events are for local evangelism. We have only set aside 10 days for overseas evangelism.
- Great Commission Center International's former chairman, Pastor Wang, once said, "If we wait until we have spread the gospel to all our local neighbors before we spread the gospel to those overseas, then Jesus' saving grace would have still remained in Jerusalem after 2000 years. Even 'til now, there are still many in Jerusalem who have yet to believe in Jesus."
